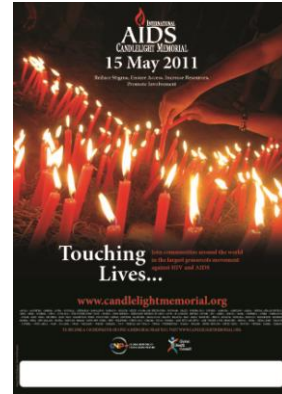

The series of thefts include incidents at SusieCakes Bakery and the Apple Store. There has also been an armed robbery at Williams Sonoma and an attempted armed robbery a few doors down at the Gap Body store. Both incidents occurred in broad daylight during normal business hours.</p> <p>SAFE and the SFPD urge residents and merchants to be aware and alert and to report any suspicious activities to the police. SAFE can provide many services to the community, including Neighborhood & Business Watch organizing.
