AS HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS COME TO CELEBRATE PRIDE IN SAN FRANCISCO AND THE CASTRO, PLEASE TAKE A FEW MOMENTS TO ENSURE YOU ENJOY SAFE AND HAPPY FESTIVITIES





San Francisco PRIDE is one of the largest events that occurs in the city every year. It attracts hundreds of thousands of visitors to the city and the Castro district. While it is a time for reflection, recognition, enjoyment and looking forward to future advances, it is also a time to exercise some simple caution and care to ensure you enjoy the festivities.

- Don't over-indulge. Intoxication is a significant factor in assaults, robberies and worse. Have fun, but don't lose control.
- Plan the events you will attend and know how you will get there, whom you will go with and how you will get home afterward. Keep a \$20 note as a back-up somewhere, to use for a taxi if you are "under the weather."
- If possible, have fun with friends and designate a "clean, clear and sober" person to help look after the driving, or taxi's etc.
- Take only what you need with you when you go out to enjoy the festivities. Some cash, your ID, and maybe one credit card or ATM card is probably all you will need. Taking more just runs the risk of losing more if you lose your wallet or purse.
- Remain aware of your surroundings, and who is around you, at all times. If things don't feel right, they probably aren't right. Leave or call police if necessary.
- Don't accept food or drink from strangers as they could be laced with any number of "additives" that may well not agree with you. It's also a good idea to keep a close eye on your drink in bars and clubs to ensure no-one slips anything into it that you don't want in it.
- Walk away from arguments before they become too "heated." Call police if necessary, but don't get into a physical altercation if you can avoid it. Pride weekend in jail or in hospital is typically just not as much fun!
- If you see ANYTHING suspicious or illegal, call 911 right away. Your call could save someone else's life or property.
- If you are a victim, call 911 and press charges.
- Most importantly – enjoy SF PRIDE month and enjoy the festivities centered around June 26/26.
