SAFETY AND SECURITY TIPS, ADVICE AND INTEREST ITEMS

LGBT BAR/CLUB OWNERS SAFETY SYMPOSIUM



The San Francisco Police Department, the SFPD LGBT Forum and SF-SAFE will meet with LGBT bar and club owners soon, to discuss ways in which general safety and security can be enhanced and improved in a collaborative and mutually beneficial way. Some steps have already been taken in the SOMA area under the SFPD Entertainment Liaison officer, Cmdr. Richard Corriea, as well as some that have begun in the Castro neighborhood under the Mission Station LGBT Liaison officer, Sgt. Chuck Limbert.

The hope of the symposium is to highlight areas of mutual concern, identify simple and cost effective opportunities to eradicate or mitigate some, and to develop a strong collaborative approach to addressing the more difficult or challenging problems as a group, rather than as individual entities.

A number of concerns will be addressed, and we hope to find some additional creative solutions as we move forward:

- Petty theft within establishments of phones, wallets, laptops, jackets etc.
- Roofied/spiked drinks where unsuspecting patrons are sometimes robbed or worse
- Noise problems in the immediate area of clubs and bars
- Well trained and empowered door staff, security staff and bar staff to identify and mitigate possible problems early
- Over intoxicated individuals who pose a danger to themselves
- Other matters of concern,

The hope is that by applying some simple concepts and strategies, many of these concerns and challenges may be significantly reduced, and that would be a good thing for the entire city, as well as for patrons and neighbors of these bars and clubs. It makes sense to use strategies that work well in other areas of San Francisco, and other cities around the world rather than trying to re-invent the wheel, thus part of the collaboration will be to identify problems and possible solutions, then test implement them to verify results.

This will hopefully be an on-going process that is aimed at making San Francisco safer for everyone.
