**A CHILD GOES MISSING EVERY 40 SECONDS IN AMERICA. SADLY
MANY NEVER RETURN HOME. THIS NEW F.B.I. APP MAY JUST HELP!**



You're shopping at the mall with your children when one of them suddenly disappears. A quick search of the nearby area is unsuccessful. What do you do?

Now there's a free new tool from the FBI that can help.

The just launched Child ID app—the first mobile application created by the FBI—provides a convenient place to electronically store photos and vital information about your children so that it's literally right at hand if you need it. You can show the pictures and provide physical identifiers such as height and weight to security or police officers on the spot. Using a special tab on the app, you can also quickly and easily e-mail the information to authorities with a few clicks.

The app also includes tips on keeping children safe as well as specific guidance on what to do in those first few crucial hours after a child goes missing.

Right now, the Child ID app is only available for use on iPhones and can only be downloaded for free from the App Store on iTunes, but we plan to expand this tool to other types of mobile devices in the near future. And we'll be adding new features—including the ability to upload other photos stored on your smart phone—in the coming weeks and months.

We encourage you to share the word about this app with family and friends, especially during upcoming activities in your communities to raise awareness on crime and drug prevention.

For its part, the FBI is working to publicize the app with the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA)—its long-time partner in the National Child Identification Program, which provides a physical kit to gather your child's pictures, fingerprints, personal characteristics, and even DNA to keep with you in case of emergency. The AFCA is producing a public service announcement about the app and will spread the word at various football games during the upcoming season.

If you hear or know of anything crime or safety related happening within our neighborhood which you believe others should be aware of, please let us know by sending an e-mail to KenCraig@CommunityPatrolUSA.org . We will be sure to pass on any information received to the most appropriate referral organization.

NOTE however, you should **ALWAYS** contact **SFPD FIRST** to report criminal acts or crimes in progress.

The South Beach Community On Patrol Service (SB-COPS) initiative is a non-profit group of unpaid volunteers who live, work, or play in the community and donate their time to walk, bicycle or drive in regular citizen safety patrols as an extra set of "eyes and ears" for law enforcement.

SB-COPS volunteers undergo a three hour training class and then join a volunteer patroller pool. You are notified of SB-COPS shifts by e-mail and can sign up to help our for part, or all of the shift time needed. SB-COPS provide a visible safety presence and also provide information, advice and act as ambassadors for the neighborhood. Any persons 18 years or older is eligible. SB-COPS do not break up fights or arrest people.
